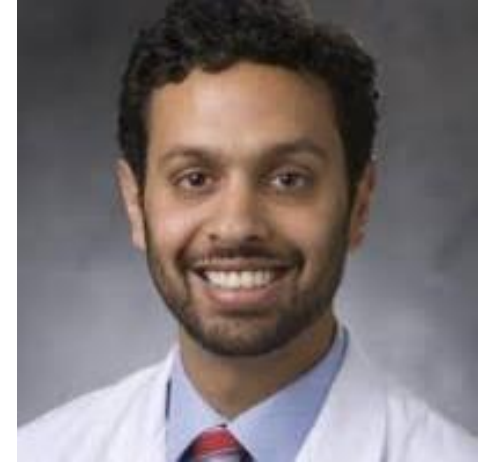

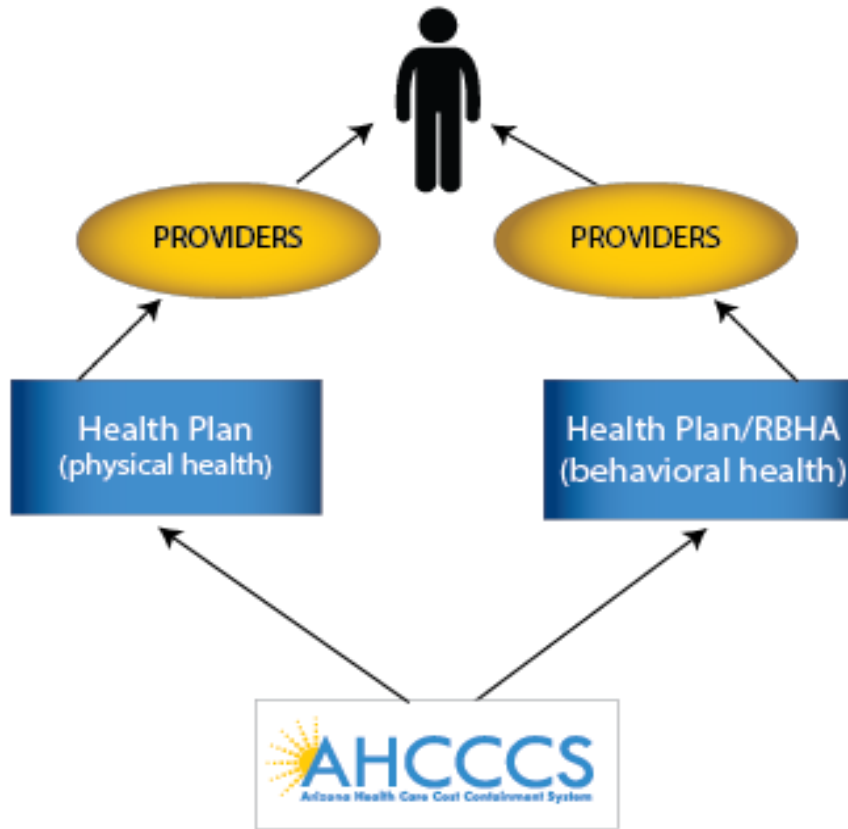

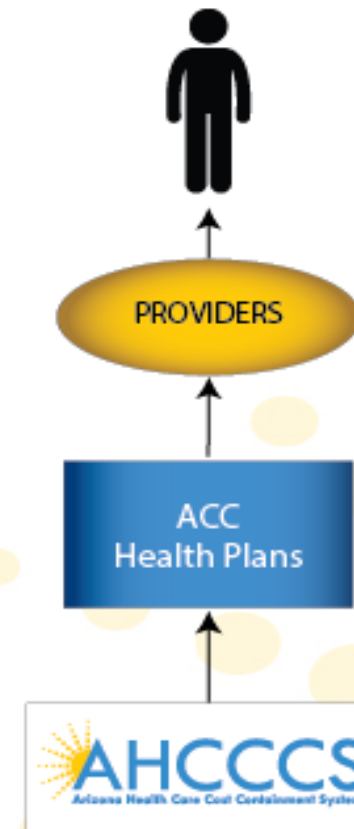

# VBP Ex. Leveraging Integration

MMIC Forensic Assertive Community Treatment

August 1, 2014 through September 30, 2016 – 3 Teams

1. 31% reduction in psychiatric hospital admissions
2. 18% reduction in the number of members who use ED
3. 19% reduction in the number of homeless members
4. 76% reduction in number of jail bookings
5. 84% increase in the percent of members who have seen medical provider at least once per year

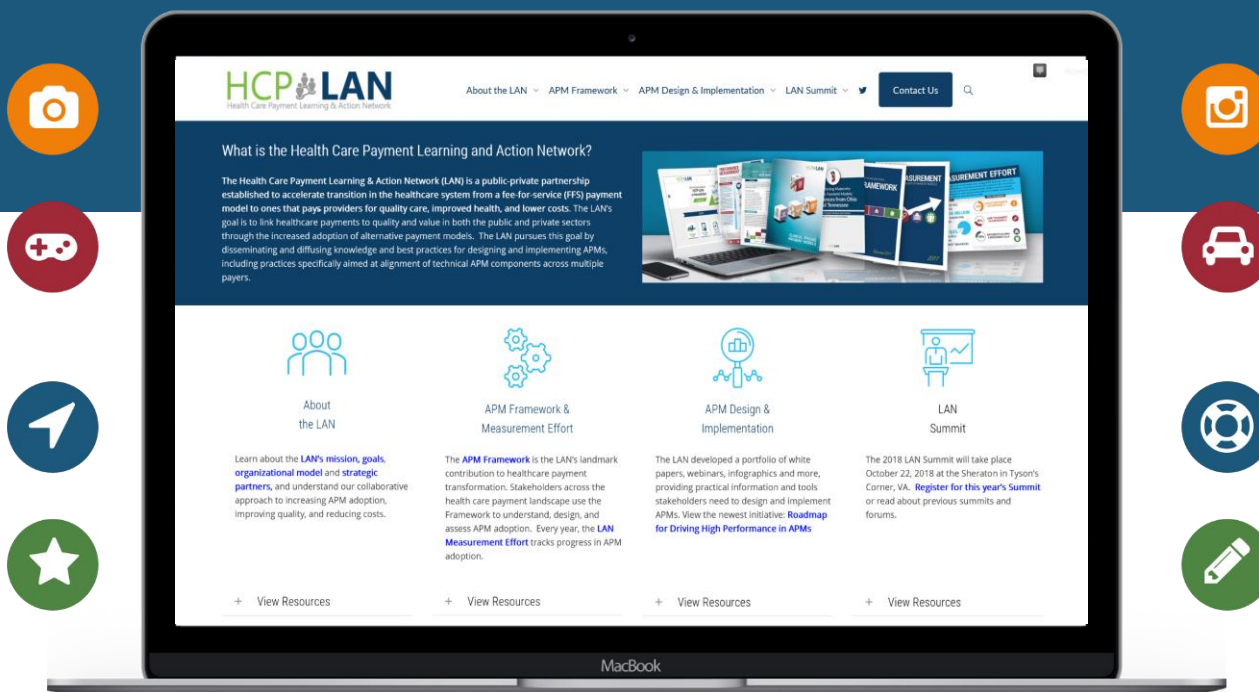

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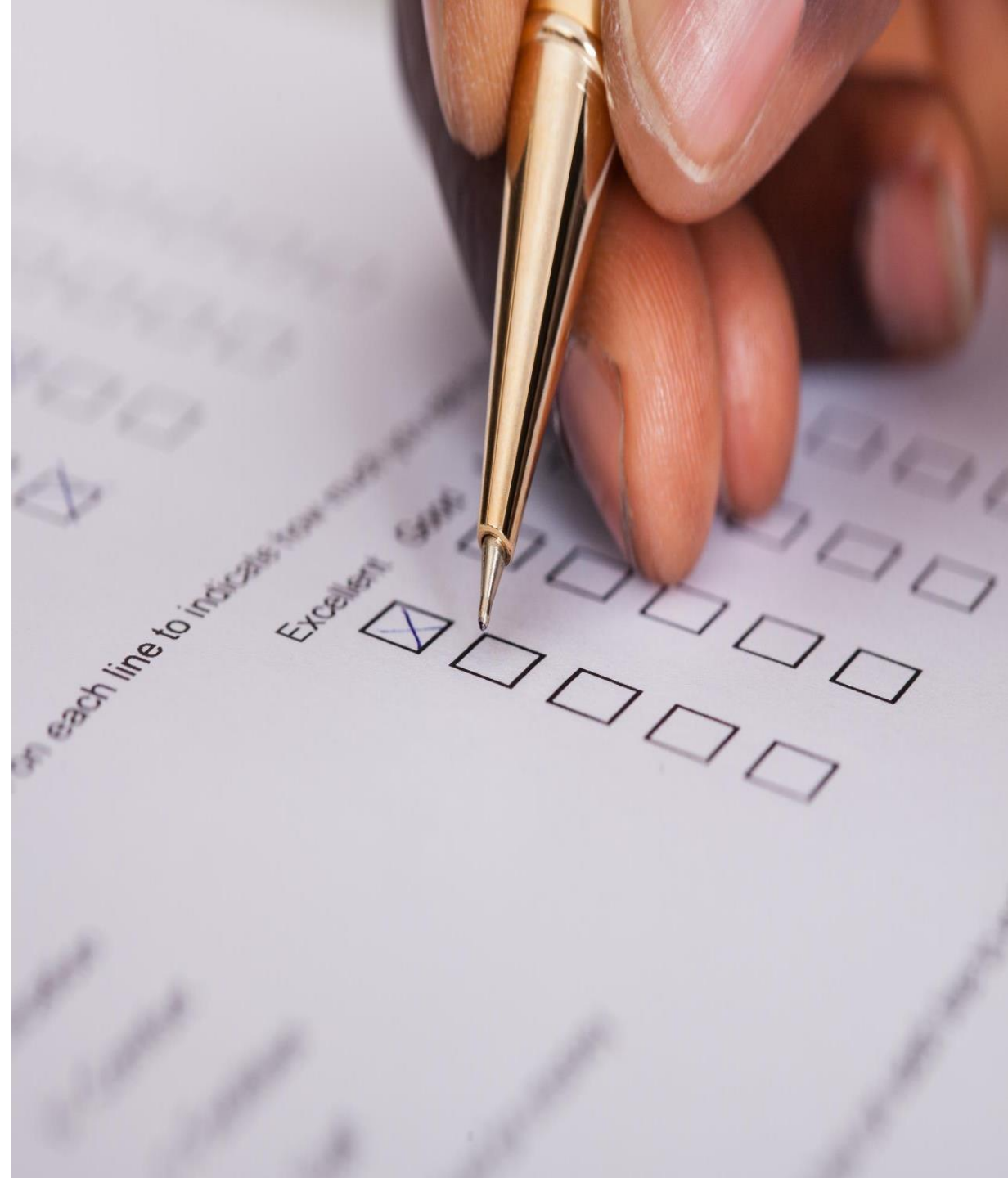
